RANDY BRADLEY RECEIVES WASTEWATER OUTSTANDING ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

Hot Springs, Ark. – Randy Bradley, pretreatment coordinator/lead operator for the City Corporation/Russellville Water and Sewer, received the Arkansas Wastewater Outstanding Achievement Award for cities serving populations more than 5,000. The award was presented at the annual Arkansas Water Works & Water Environment Association in Hot Springs on April 27.



Bradley has served a number of roles since joining City Corporation in 1990. His duties have included serving as a lab analyst, lab manager and lead operator at the city's wastewater treatment plant.

Bradley is cited in his nomination as a vital component to City Corporation's management team for his knowledge regarding both the collection and treatment aspects of the city's wastewater system and for his troubleshooting skills for correcting issues at the treatment plant. As well, his nomination cites his integrity is as impressive as his work record.

Among Bradley's other accomplishments, he has served for 32 years in the U.S. Air Force, first on active duty for four years, and then for seven years in the Air Force Reserves. He has been a member of the Arkansas Air National Guard for 21 years. He was selected as the 188th Fighter Wing First Sergeant of the Year in 2006, First Sergeant of the Year for the state of Arkansas in 2006, Wing Command Chief for the 188th Wing in 2012 and City Corporation Employee of the year for 2004.

Bradley, originally from Pottsville, worked for three years as that city's manager of the water and sewer departments. He and his wife of 32 years, Denise Bradley, still reside in Pottsville. They have two children and four grandchildren.
