Hot Springs, Ark. – Shannon Wayson is this year’s recipient of the Water Environment Federation’s Laboratory Analyst Award. The award was presented at the annual AWW&WEA meeting in Hot Springs on April 27.



Wayson has been a chemist for the North Little Rock Wastewater Utility for nine years. She serves as the chair of the AWEA Laboratory Pretreatment Committee and is the past chair of the AWW&WEA Drinking Water Contest. She was recognized with this award due to her outstanding contributions to the water quality analysis profession. Among these, she has been active in the state’s education program for water conservation. Specifically she works with about 400 elementary school children annually within the North Little Rock School District.

Wayson is a member of the AWEA and WEF, and holds a Class III wastewater operator’s license and a Class B industrial wastewater license.
