### **JAMES CLARK NAMED ARKANSAS WATER WORKS OUTSTANDING ACHIEVEMENT WINNER 2017**

Hot Springs, Ark. – James Clark, public works director for the city of Tontitown, received the Arkansas Water Works Outstanding Achievement Award for utilities serving a population of less than 5,000.
