ROBERT PUGSLEY NAMED ARKANSAS WASTEWATER OUTSTANDING ACHIEVEMENT WINNER 2017

Hot Springs, Ark. – Robert Pugsley, utility systems operator for the National Park Service, received the Wastewater Outstanding Achievement Award for utilities serving a population of less than 5,000. The award was presented recently at the annual Arkansas Water Works & Water Environment Association (AWW&WEA) Conference in Hot Springs.

Pugsley is responsible for maintaining several wastewater and water systems serving the area of the Buffalo National River. He has dedicated his 41-year career to serving the residents of Yellville and the visitors of the Buffalo National River. 6 years.

Among his career accomplishments, Pugsley was instrumental in obtaining funding for two new wastewater treatment plants for Buffalo Point, on the Buffalo National River. These two plants, scheduled for completion in 2018, will replace aging plants that are no longer adequate.

This is the second time Pugsley has been honored at the AWW&WEA annual meeting, having received the Individual Achievement Award in 2012.
